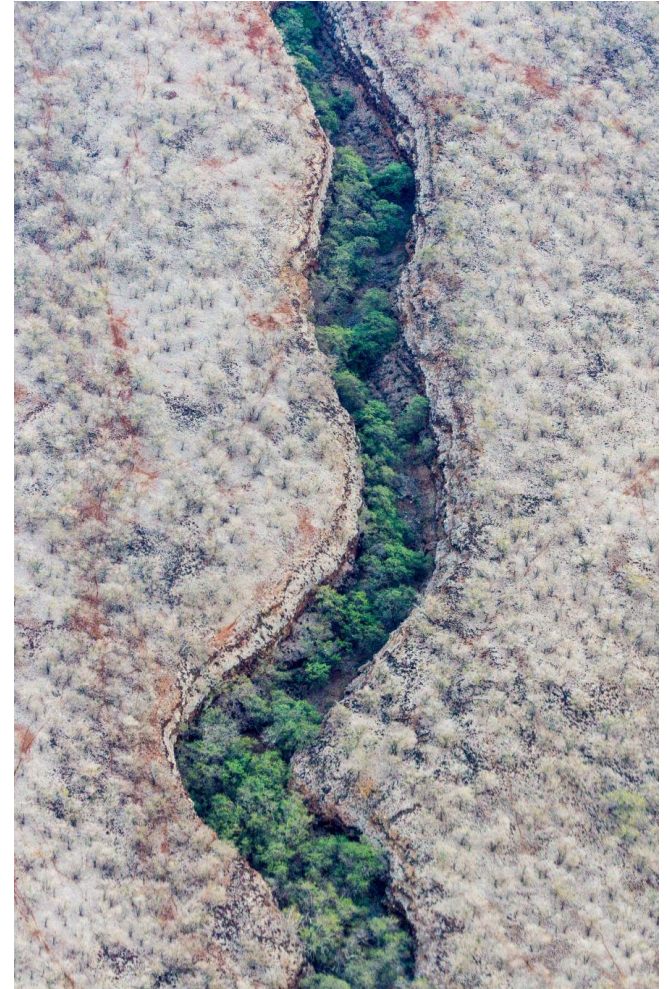

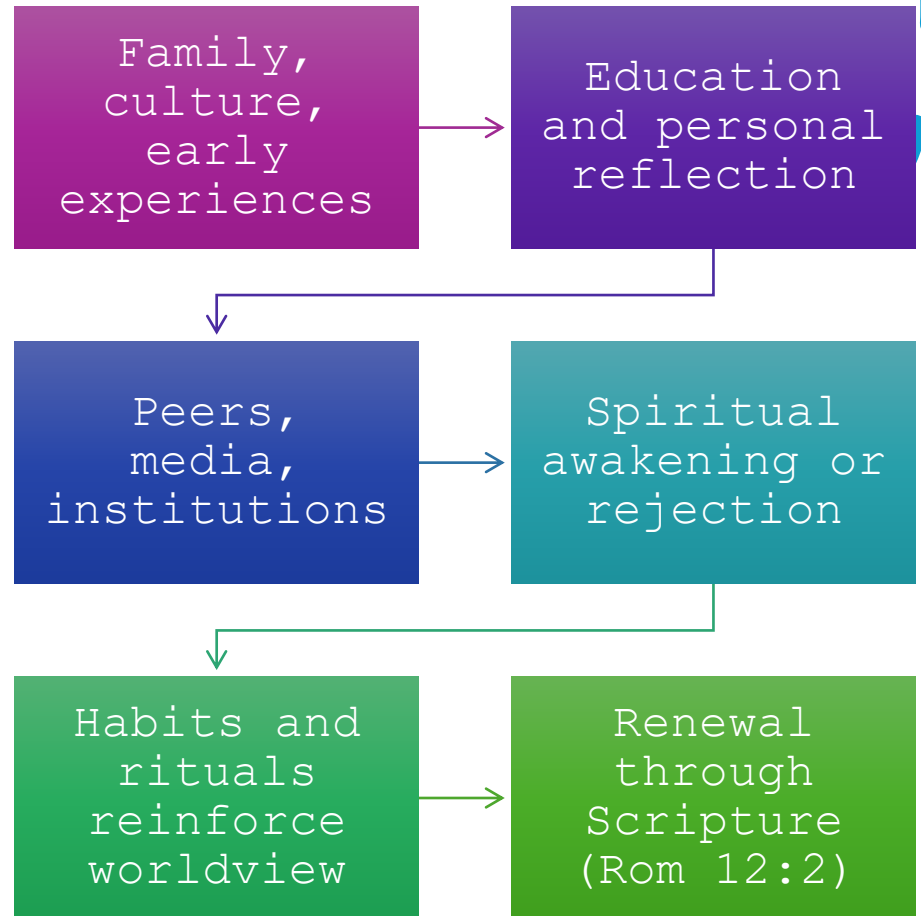


What is a Worldview?

- Worldview = how we interpret reality
- Answers origin, purpose, ethics, destiny
- Reality (metaphysics),
Knowing (epistemology),
Conduct (ethics)
- Shaped by culture, family, education, religion

Operating System



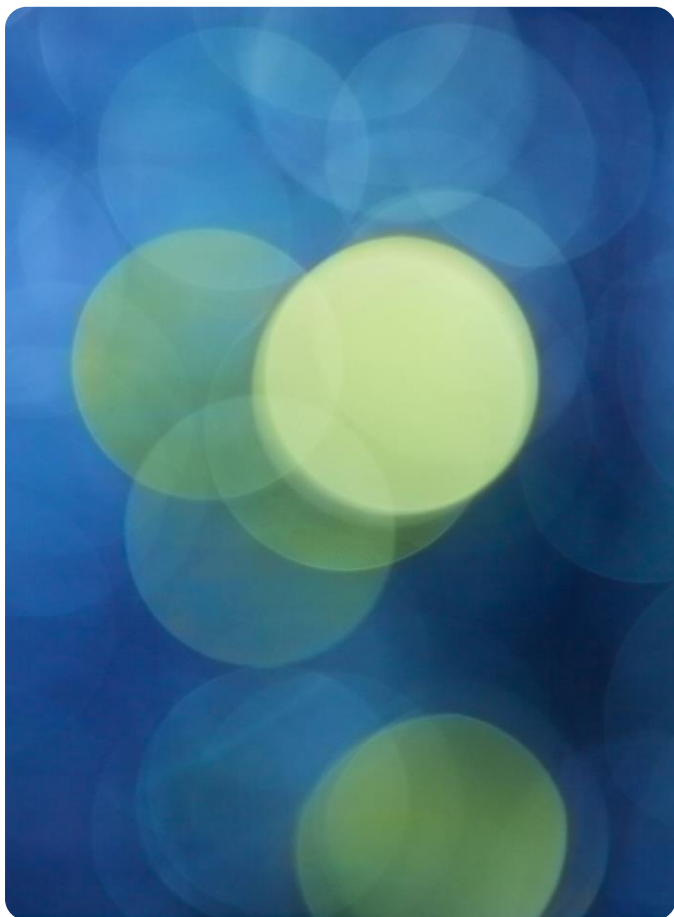
Secular OS: God-

God-centered

Challenges to Christian Worldview

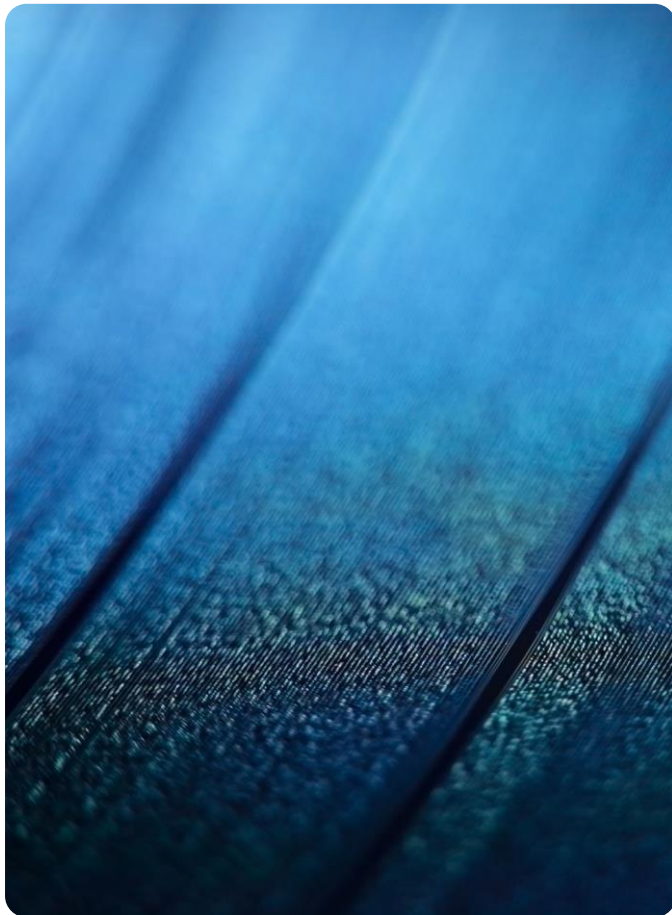

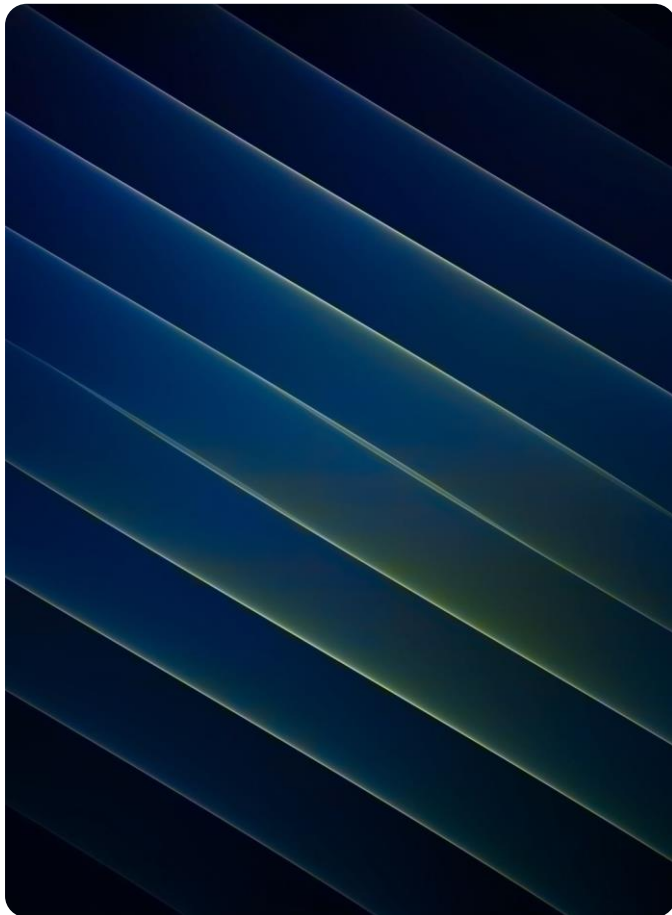


Biblical Foundations for Worldview
