Prof. Dr. P.J. (Flip) Buys has served as a minister and missionary since 1973. He was the first Principal of Mukhanyo Theological College and currently serves as a research professor of Missiology and Practical Theology at the North-West University in Potchefstroom. He is also serving as the International Director of World Reformed Fellowship. He has published several academic articles and textbooks for beginners in Homiletics, Pastoral Theology, Christian Character Formation and Systematic Theology.



Rev. Peter Manzanga (Dip in Biblical Studies, BA.Th., BA. Hons., MA. NT., PhD candidate) studied at the Bible Institute of South Africa and George Whitefield College. He was Lecturer and Principal of Rusitu Bible College for ten years and is currently the resident pastor of Hatfield United Baptist Church based in Harare. Rev Manzanga has also taught modules at Harare Theological College and Mukhanyo Theological College in South Africa. He is still a visiting lecturer at Rusitu Bible College. He is married to Alice and are blessed with three boys and three girls.



Rev. Dr In Whan Kim is the President/Vice Chancellor of Swaziland Christian University. He is Professor Emeritus and Former President of Chongshin University and Seminary in Seoul, Korea. He is also President of Theological Universities in Korean Council for University Education. He is also serves as a director on the board for World Reformed Fellowship and on the board of trustees for Westminster Theological Seminary in Philadelphia, USA.



Dr. Brian A de Vries (BBA, M.Div., Th.M., Ph.D.) is Principal and Senior Lecturer at Mukhanyo Theological College. He is a minister of the Reformed Churches of South Africa (GKSA), sent to South Africa in 2005 as a missionary of the Heritage Reformed Congregations of North America (HRC-NA). Dr de Vries is presently leading his third church plant in South Africa and also serves as senior lecturer in the Faculty of Theology at North-West University and visiting professor at Puritan Reformed Theological Seminary in the United States. He and his wife, Lanae, have three children.



Dr. Conrad Mbewe has served as pastor of Kabwata Baptist Church since 1987 and has been the principal of the Lusaka Ministerial College during various periods of its existence. He is a graduate of the Cape Town Baptist Seminary in South Africa and holds a Master of Arts (MA) in Pastoral Theology and a Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in Missions. He is the chancellor of the African Christian University, chairs the board of trustees of the African Renaissance University of the African Alliance of YMCAs, and is a board member of the Central Africa Baptist College and the Covenant College Zambia. He is the author of several books and articles and the editor of *Reformation Zambia*.



Prof. Basilius Kasera (BTS, PGDipTE, and MTh) joined the *Namibia Evangelical Theological (NETS)* in 2010, served as the Academic Dean (2012-2015) and lecturer of Systematic Theology and Contextual Theology. Besides teaching theology, he serves as council member on the *National Council for Higher Education*, theological advisor and speaker for the *Southern African Christian Initiative*, and as a part-time lecturer of philosophy and applied ethics at the *University of Namibia*. Rev. Jim Wright lectures New Testament and Biblical Languages at *John Wycliffe Theological College* in Johannesburg where he is also the Academic Dean. He also serves as the principal of Heidelberg Theological Seminary of the Reformed Churches of the General Synod Soutpansberg.
